SRSB IBN CHAMBAS CONDEMNS THE ATTACKS IN ADAMAWA STATE (NIGERIA)

Dakar, 22 November 2017 - The Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Office for West Africa and the Sahel (UNOWAS), Mohamed Ibn Chamba condemns the suicide attacks on 21 November in Adamawa State, Nigeria, which resulted in several casualties.

Mohamed Ibn Chamba expresses his sincere condolences to the families of the victims and to the Government and people of Nigeria. He hopes that the perpetrators of these crimes will be swiftly brought to justice.
