<b>JOB DESCRIPTION:</b>	<p>Under the direct supervision of the Supervisor (Engineering Technician) the incumbent will perform the following functions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide preliminary sketches and cost estimates for materials and services;</li> <li>• Carry out fault diagnosis and carry out forward planning on assigned work/projects;</li> <li>• Repair and Maintain security barriers;</li> <li>• Repair and maintain generators;</li> <li>• Ensure spares or materials lists are compiled in good time for work assigned;</li> <li>• Installs and maintains the generator wiring, electric motors and machines;</li> <li>• Repairs electrical faults in generators, alternators, pumps, electric motors and low voltage switchboards;</li> <li>• Installs generator sets complete generating stations;</li> <li>• Inspects maintains and repairs generator sets and diesel driven pumps;</li> <li>• Overhauls and rebuilds generators;</li> </ul>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Responsible for the safe and efficient use of tools and specialized equipment;</li> <li>• Plan, produce, and assemble new or changed mechanical parts for products, such as security barriers, generators and other engineering equipment;</li> <li>• Set up and conduct tests of complete units and components under operational conditions to investigate proposals for improving equipment performance;</li> <li>• Coordinate preventive and corrective maintenance and repairs on all the security barriers, generators, Air Conditions system and General Mechanical works;</li> <li>• Assess maintenance needs of generators, parts replacement requirements and make appropriate recommendations;</li> <li>• Carry out routine checks on generators and air conditioning and equipment, and review performance;</li> <li>• Perform other duties related to facilities support as and when required.</li> </ul>
<b>COMPETENCIES:</b>	<p><b>Professionalism:</b> Shows pride in work and in achievements; demonstrates professional competence and mastery of subject matter; is conscientious and efficient in meeting commitments, observing deadlines and achieving results; is motivated by professional rather than personal concerns; shows persistence when faced with difficult problems or challenges; remains calm in stressful situations.
